Wheatfield Lake Recreation Area

- ◉ Wheatfield Lake constructed in 1962 as a multi-use reservoir
- ◉ Tsaile/Wheatfield Chapter passed resolution recommending withdraw of 135 acres for recreational park in December 1985
- ◉ Wheatfield Lake Recreation Area Conceptual Recreational Site Plan developed in 2008
 - Phase I (\$1.42 million)
 - Phase II (\$1.01 million)
 - Phase III (\$0.33 million)
- ◉ Fishing, Boating, Camping



Completed Projects

- ◉ Lake Barriers
 - No driving on shorelines
 - Prevents erosion
 - Maintains water quality
- ◉ Restrooms
 - 3 restroom facilities installed
- ◉ Trash Bins
- ◉ Signs
- ◉ Grills
- ◉ Renovated picnic tables

 - Thrown down restrooms









Trash Pickup


Lbs of Trash Collected

Number of Fish Stocked at Wheatfield Lake




Creel Surveys

- Only takes a minute of your time!




FY'14 as of 6/9/14

Number of Anglers Interviewed




FY'14 as of 6/9/14
