## **ATTENTION MOTORISTS: IT'S MULE DEER MIGRATION SEASON!!**

From **April 10<sup>th</sup> – April 30<sup>th</sup>** the majority of Navajo Nation's mule deer populations will be migrating to greener pastures for the summer. Navajo Fish & Wildlife has identified 3 high-use migration corridor zones that cross over rural highways (maps below). Please use caution while driving in these zones during these dates – at night, reduce speed and remain vigilant, scanning the road ahead for 'eye shine'. Call (928) 871-6489 to leave a message and report locations of any roadkill mule deer (or elk) observed on Navajo Nation within these dates.

Zone A: Rt 12 north of Tsaile until Lukachukai, HWY 64 west of Tsaile, and Rt 12 south of Tsaile.

Zone B: Rt 12 within the Wheatfields Lake area.

Zone C: HWY 264 section that intersects McKinley Mine area, from NDOT to Speedy's gas station.
