- ❖ Fill out a Navajo Nation Big Game Hunt Application
- ❖ 2015 Annual Youth Hunt Application Form
- ❖ One-Page Essay (see next Section)
- ❖ Provide Contact Information of Two (2) Adult References

ON A SEPARATE SHEET OF PAPER, PREPARE A ONE-PAGE SHORT ESSAY THAT INCLUDES:

1. Why do you want to hunt?
2. Explain why you do not have the opportunity to hunt. If relatives hunt, explain why you haven't joined them.
3. Have you or any of your family members (father, step-father, mother, step-mother, uncles, aunts, grandparents, siblings) hunted before? If yes, please provide a list of relatives who hunt and their relation to you.
4. Tell us about your interest(s) in hunting, fishing or other outdoor recreational activities?

QUALIFICATION:

- ❖ Must be 12 – 16 years of age
- ❖ Must be an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation.
- ❖ Must be drug/alcohol free.
- ❖ Must be able to follow instructions.
- ❖ Must **HAVE NEVER HUNTED** before and have **ABSOLUTELY** no other hunting opportunities available.
- ❖ Must be physically fit to hike in rough terrain, camp out and safely handle a firearm.
- ❖ If selected, you must attend and participate in a mandatory 20-hour Hunter Education Course and two (02) Firearm Range Practice Days (provided by the Department of Fish and Wildlife). This is mandatory; otherwise, you will be disqualified.
- ❖ Must have **NEVER PARTICIPATED** in a previous Navajo Nation Department of Fish and Wildlife Annual Youth Hunt event.
- ❖ Must have never been issued a big game hunt permit.
