# Shelters

- ▣ A Dog House.

  - b. Provides Shade
  - c. Protects them from winter and wet conditions



# Feeding

- ▣ Make sure your pet has Food.

- ▣ Pets should be Fed daily.

# Obey Navajo Nation Animal Control Laws

- ▣ License:

- a. Pet Identification Tag
  - b. Navajo Nation Pet License

- ▣ Vaccination:

- a. Proof of Rabies Vaccination

- ▣ Restrain or Confine:

- a. Dogs have to be tied up
  - b. Dog has to be within a fenced area capable of confining the dog
