- There is really only two simple ways that hunters and fishermen need to do to stay out of trouble with game wardens.
 - Rule 1
 - Don't Hunt and Fish
 - Rule 2
 - Follow the laws and regulations that govern the area you choose to Hunt and Fish at.

• Hunting Issues

- Validate your Hunting Permit when you receive it,
- Keep your permit intact-Do not separate the permit until you make a kill,
- If your born after January 1, 1970 have your Hunter Ed Card in your possession while hunting,
- Do not hunt from a vehicle unless you receive special permission from Fish and Wildlife in writing,
- Have a form of identification with you when checked by officers,
- Make sure firearms are unloaded and in a case when in a vehicle,
- Hunting without a permit- Hunting is permitted by permit only. It's a privilege-not a right

HOW TO STAY OUT OF TROUBLE WITH GAME WARDENS

• Hunting Issues

- Validate the back of your permit when you make a successful kill,
- Do not use another person permit while hunting,
- Do not use artificial light while hunting- Hunting is allowed during daylight hours only. From designated sunrise to sun down hours.
- Do not use alcohol or drugs while hunting.
- Keep camp site cleaner then when you got there.
- Do not possess a firearm while hunting with archery equipment during a archery hunt
- All persons in a hunting party either hunting or assisting a hunter must wear hunter orange during designated hunt that require hunter orange.

1. IMMEDIATELY UPON KILL DETACH THIS TAG.
2. SIGN AND CUT OUT THE SEX OF KILL AND THE MONTH AND DAY OF KILL.
3. TAG MUST BE ATTACHED (USE HOLES IN TAG) TO THE CARCASS BEFORE IT IS TRANSPORTED IN ANY VEHICLE OR WHILE IN CAMP, AT A RESIDENCY OR OTHER PLACE OF STORAGE.
4. TAG MUST BE ATTACHED SO THAT IT CAN BE READILY INSPECTED.
5. TAG IS VOID IF DETACHED AND CANNOT BE USED AGAIN.
6. THE INADVERTENT OR ACCIDENTAL DETACHMENT OF THIS TAG RENDERS LICENSE VOID.

SUMMARY OF HUNTING REGULATIONS

It is unlawful for a person to:

- Shoot from, take or attempt to take, any wildlife from a motor vehicle.
- Shoot from, along or across a graded or paved road.
- Take or attempt to take any wildlife with the aid of any artificial light.
- Possess a firearm with live ammunition in the firing chamber in or on any motor vehicle.
- Litter hunting and fishing areas while taking wildlife.
- Possess any alcoholic beverages or liquor while taking wildlife.
- Possess or transport big game or parts thereof without a proper carcass tag attached.
- Violate any provisions of Navajo Nation Wildlife Regulation or Supplements or 17 NTC 500 of the Navajo Tribal Code.

• Fishing Issues

- No Permit-All fishing require a permit-it's a privilege to fish-not a right,
- Littering ,
- Failure to comply with Fishing Permit requirements,
- Using live Bait-minnows are not allowed,
- Using live gold fish as bait,
- Catching fish by netting,
- Snagging Fish
- Possession of Alcohol or drugs
- No second rod validation
- Using kids as decoy so you don't receive a citation for no permit.

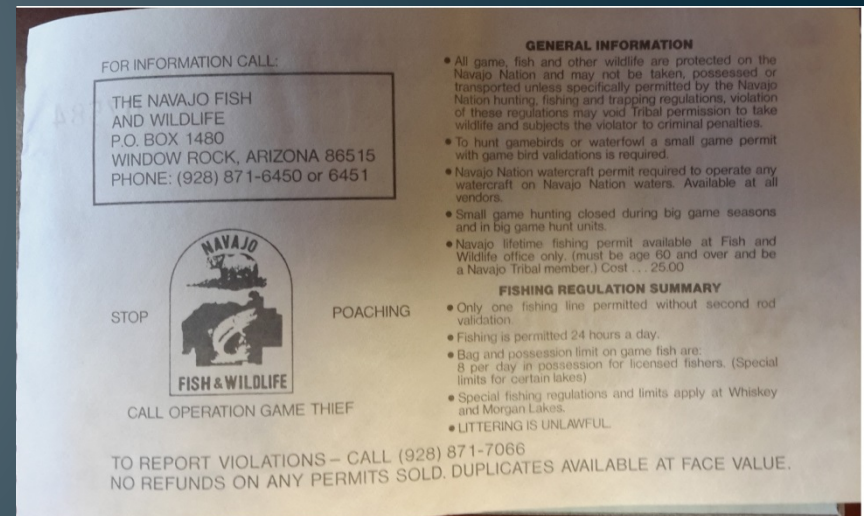

HOW TO STAY OUT OF TROUBLE WITH GAME WARDENS

- While fishing be honest with game wardens,
- If the people you are with walk off from your location have them put there equipment away,
- Fishing is a privilege, its not a right.
- Navajo Nation Permits are required for taking any wildlife off of Navajo Nation lands.,
- Know the rules and regulation that cover fishing, it is your responsibility to know these laws if you plan to fish.



HOW TO STAY OUT OF TROUBLE WITH GAME WARDENS



- Boating:
 - Know your boating requirements
 - Always follow coast guard rules for equipment on your boats.
 - Always have an adult present with children under 16 in a boat
 - Know the weight limit of the craft
 - Always have everyone wear a life jacket
 - Be aware of the weather while on a boat.
 - Gas motors are not permitted on Navajo Nation Lakes except Morgan Lake.
