CONDITIONS:

- **SEASON DATES:** September 1, 2020 – January 31, 2021 (Any 30 Days)
- **HUNT UNITS OPEN:** Navajo Nation Wide
- Use of aircraft prohibited
- Use of snow mobiles and all-terrain vehicles prohibited (exception, Sec. 2.20, Hunting and Trapping Regulations)
- There is a mandatory permit check in and out
- A licensed Navajo Nation guide is required and must accompany the hunter any time he/she is on Navajo Nation lands, including during scouting activities prior to the hunt. The Department of Fish and Wildlife is not responsible for arrangements made between a guide and a client, and the quality of guide services provided.
- No hunter companions, except for immediate family members
- No refunds
- Permit cannot be transferred
- The successful bidder must also submit a completed Navajo Nation Hunt Application in order for permit to be printed
- Successful bidder must be eligible to hunt on the Navajo Nation
- The successful hunter must have their deer checked by Department personnel to collect harvest information.
- 10% of the proceeds will be retained by NGA.
- The NGA will pay the remaining 90% of the proceeds to the Navajo Nation Department of Fish and Wildlife.
