LEFT-OVER PERMIT SALES PROCEDURES
JULY 22, 2023

1. Left-Over Permits will be made available to those individuals that applied but were unsuccessful in the 2023-2024 Big Game Hunt Draw beginning at 8:00 A.M. on July 22, 2023. A numbered ticket will be distributed to each applicant or their representative that wishes to apply for a left-over permit.
2. At 10:00 AM, numbered tickets will begin to be drawn.
3. After 10:00 AM, no more tickets will be distributed.
4. Each person is limited to submitting up to two (2) applications per numbered ticket drawn.
5. Only the person holding the numbered ticket is authorized to purchase left-over permits. Numbered tickets cannot be transferred.
6. Once a numbered ticket is drawn, the individual who holds the numbered ticket must immediately purchase his/her permits. Failure to do this will result in that numbered ticket being disqualified and another numbered ticket will be drawn.
7. Only credit/debit cards will be accepted as payment for each permit sold. No cash, money orders or cashier's checks will be accepted. Drawn ticket holders will be responsible for paying the entire permit cost at the time their ticket is drawn. Permit costs for each hunt code are specified in the 2023/2024 Navajo Nation Hunting Proclamation.
8. As each drawn person completes their purchase, another numbered ticket will be drawn and this process will continue until all permits are sold or until each person with a numbered ticket is given the opportunity to purchase left-over permits.
9. At 1:00 pm, in the event there are still left-over permits available, permit sales will open up to the general public. Eligibility rules still apply. The process will start over with Step 1 and continue until all left-over permits are sold.
10. At 1:00 PM, numbered tickets will begin to be drawn.
11. After 3:00 PM, no more tickets will be distributed.
12. Incomplete applications will not be accepted (i.e. penalty and permit fees and any required documentation must accompany the application). Failure to have required fees and/or documentation attached will result in the application being rejected.
13. Leftover permits will be mailed out no later than 1 week prior to the beginning of the hunt
14. Any remaining left-over permits will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis until sold out or until the day before the hunt. Permits purchased after July 22, 2023 must be picked up in person at the Fish and Wildlife office.
