2025 LEFT-OVER PERMIT SALES PROCEDURES

1. Left-Over Permits will be sold to those individuals that applied but were unsuccessful in the 2025-2026 Big Game Hunt Draw beginning at 8:00 A.M. on July 12, 2025. A numbered ticket will be distributed to each applicant or their representative that wishes to apply for a left-over permit.
2. Left-over permit sales will be done using the paper big game hunting application and the Credit Card Authorization Forms which are available on-line as fillable forms and also will be available in person at the Fish and Wildlife Office prior to and during the left-over permit sale.
3. Tickets will be distributed at 8:00 AM until all individuals present have received a ticket. Tickets will begin to be drawn immediately after everyone present receives a ticket.
4. Individuals are limited to submitting a maximum of two (2) applications per numbered ticket drawn.
5. Only the person holding the numbered ticket is authorized to purchase left-over permits.
6. Once a numbered ticket is drawn, the individual who holds the numbered ticket must immediately present their ticket and purchase their permit(s). Failure to present their ticket immediately will result in that numbered ticket being disqualified.
7. All applications will be screened for eligibility. An applicant must be eligible to hunt at the time they apply.
8. As each drawn person completes their purchase, another numbered ticket will be drawn and this process will continue until all permits are sold or until each person with a numbered ticket is given the opportunity to purchase left-over permits.
9. In the event that there are still left-over permits available, permit sales will open up to anyone wanting a left-over permit. When all individuals receive a ticket, tickets will be drawn and permits will be sold until all tickets are called and no one else is present to purchase a left-over permit.
10. Any remaining left-over permits will be sold on a first come, first served basis beginning on July 14, 2025.
11. Incomplete applications will not be accepted (i.e. penalty, required documentation must accompany the application). Failure to have required fees and/or documentation attached will result in the application being rejected.
