#### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- v Fill out a Navajo Nation Big Game Hunt Application
- v 2025 Annual Youth Hunt Application Form
- v One-Page Essay (see next Section)

#### ON A SEPARATE SHEET OF PAPER, PREPARE A ONE-PAGE SHORT ESSAY THAT INCLUDES:

- Why do you want to hunt?
- v Explain why you do not have the opportunity to hunt.
- V Have you or any of your family members (father, step-father, mother, step-mother, uncles, aunts, grandparents, siblings) hunted before?
- v Tell us about your interest(s) in hunting, fishing or other outdoor recreational activities?

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- ∨ Must be 12 16 years of age
- v Must be an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation.
- V Must be drug/alcohol free.
- v Must be able to follow instructions.
- v Must HAVE NEVER HUNTED before and have ABSOLUTELY no other hunting opportunities available.
- V Must have no family members who have hunted before.
- v Must be physically fit to hike in rough terrain, camp out and safely handle a firearm.
- v If selected, you must attend and successfully complete a mandatory 20-hour Hunter Education Course and two (02) Firearm Range Practice Days (provided by the Department of Fish and Wildlife). This is mandatory; otherwise, you will be disqualified.
- v Must have **NEVER PARTICIPATED** in a previous Navajo Nation Department of Fish and Wildlife Annual Youth Hunt event.
- v Must have never been issued a big game hunt permit.

#### IF SELECTED YOU MUST:

- Successfully complete the <u>Hunter Education Certification Course</u> at a Department of Fish and Wildlife facility in Window Rock, Arizona:
