Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) affects deer, elk, and related species across the U.S. and in a few other countries. While it has not been detected on Navajo Nation *yet*, it has been found in neighboring states—Colorado, New Mexico, and Utah—and disease movement poses a threat to Navajo deer and elk.

This short survey (21 questions, under 10 minutes) is designed to understand how hunters might respond to potential CWD management strategies *if* the disease is detected on Navajo Nation lands in the future. Your responses will help the Navajo Nation Department of Fish and Wildlife (NNDFW) make informed decisions about managing CWD on tribal lands.
