### **Wolf Springs Ranch 2019 Big Game Hunts**

#### **General Information:**

- 1. Applicants must meet eligibility requirements to hunt on the Navajo Nation and the State of Colorado.
- **2.** All selected applicants are required to sign a contract with the Navajo Nation, Colorado Ranch Enterprise/Wolf Springs Ranch and pay all appropriate fees prior to issue of the voucher.
- 3. The eligible applicant must redeem the voucher for a proper and valid license **PRIOR** to hunting. The voucher may be redeemed at any license agent, or Colorado Parks & Wildlife office. The appropriate license fee(s) are paid at that time.
- **4.** All hunters are limited to 1 guest. The non-hunting guest will be charged \$100.00 dollars. The Hunter must provide the name of their guest and pay all guest fees prior to issuance of voucher.
- 5. Camping in designated area is allowed. Hotel accommodations are also available at near-by towns.
- **6.** Voucher/Access Fees of \$200.00 dollars allows use of ranch lodging accommodation. Hunter is responsible for preparation of their meals and clean-up of the facility.
- 7. No Outfitters are allowed.
- **8.** All hunts are non-guided hunts.
- **9.** Review the Colorado hunting brochure for restrictions on muzzleloaders.
- 10. Payments are final. All application fees, guest fees and voucher/access fees are non-refundable.

- The bull is 6+ years of age, weighing 1,600 to 1,900 lbs. Meat, hide and skull is the responsibility of the hunter. The processing facility can be used to quarter the animal. Hunter is responsible for cleaning, upkeep, removal of all meat scrap, tissue and hide parts from the facility.
- Lodging is included, hunter is responsible for their meals and preparation. Hunter and guest are responsible for the cleaning and upkeep of the ranch house. A damage fee of \$300.00 dollars will be assessed if property is damaged.
- No more than 2 individuals may accompany hunter.
- Ranch personnel will assist with determination of bison harvest for the safety of the hunter and other animals on the ranch.
